## INDEPENDENT AUDITORS' REPORT

We have audited the accompanying Statement of Accounts of St. John Singapore ("the Society") relating to St. John Singapore Walkathon 2018 held from 20 July 2018 to 19 October 2018. The Statement of Accounts has been prepared by the management based on the provisions of Regulation 6 of the Societies Regulation issued under the Societies Act Chapter 311, Section 34 (the "Regulations").

### *Management's Responsibility for the Statement*

Management is responsible for the preparation of the Statement of Accounts in accordance with the Regulations, and for such internal control as management determines is necessary to enable the preparation of the Statement of Accounts free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

### *Auditor's Responsibility*

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on the Statement of Accounts based on our audit. We conducted our audit in accordance with Singapore Standards on Auditing. Those standards require that we comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance whether the Statement of Accounts free of material misstatements.

As audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the Statement of Accounts, the procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgement, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatements of the Statement of Accounts, whether due to fraud or error. In making this risk assessments, the auditors consider internal controls that are relevant to the Society's preparation of the Statement of Accounts in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the Society's internal control. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates, if any, made by the management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the Statement of Accounts. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis of our audit opinion.

### *Audit Opinion*

In our opinion, the Statement of Accounts relating to St. John Singapore Walkathon 2018 held from 20 July 2018 to 19 October 2018, is prepared, in all material respects, in accordance with the Regulations.
